John-Pierre Montilla

Founder, Gabay Foundation (formerly Kabataang Gabay sa Positibong Pamumuhay (Peers for Positive Living))
Philippines

John-Pierre was a street child in the Philippines, forced into a dangerous world of drug-related crime and even child prostitution. However, he was fortunate enough to escape this dark world and has dedicated his life to using his own pain and experiences to help street children like him to do the same. Set up in 1998, John-Pierre's organization is now active in 16 locations across the country and has so far helped approx 8,000 young people in its fight to give street children a brighter future.
