Green Villas & Organic Restaurant

Timor-Leste's first model of village-based eco-tourism, showing rural communities that it is possible to generate income and make a living by leveraging their natural environment - the only resource available in the countryside.



Women's Organic Farming Co-op

Local women are given the skills, tools, seeds and products to make and care for their own organic farms in their own villages, empowering them to become self-sustainable and independent.
